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## REGULAR CONFORMATION CLASSES - For Dogs and Bitches

Junior Puppy	..... 6 months of age but under 9 months
Senior Puppy	..... 9 months of age but under 12 months
12 to 18 months	..... 12 months of age but under 18 months
Canadian Bred	..... born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor	..... owned and handled in ring by breeder
Open	..... for all dogs/bitches
Veteran	.... 7 years of age or older; do not compete for winners but for BOB
Specials	..... have previously obtained Cdn championship status

NOTE: In the Veterans class, entrants may be spayed or neutered.

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## NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Exhibition Only	.. over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with CKC
Brace	..... for 2 flat-coats owned by exactly the same owner
Stud Dog & Get	: stud dog & 2 or more of his get, not necessarily same owner
Brood Bitch & Progeny	..... brood bitch & 2 or more of her progeny, not necessarily same owner
Field Retriever	..... has WCI, WCX, SH, MH title or a CKC sanctioned field trial placement
Working Retriever	..... has a WC, JH title or 1 leg toward SH title

NOTE: Non-regular/unofficial class entrants must be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Get and Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. In the Brace, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Field, Working classes, entrants may be spayed or neutered provided they are entered in an Altered Class or in Exhibition Only.

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## SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES - For Dogs and Bitches

### Puppy Classes

Junior	..... 6 months of age but under 9 months
Senior	..... 9 months of age but under 12 months
Open	..... 12 months of age but under 18 months

### Veteran Classes

Veteran Young	..... 7 years of age but under 9 years
Veteran	..... 9 years of age but under 11 years
Veteran Plus	..... over 11 years

NOTE: Puppy Sweepstake entrants must be entered in the Regular classes. Veteran Sweepstake entrants may be entered in Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered veterans may compete provided they are entered in an Altered Class or in Exhibition Only.

## SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered. Points MAY NOT be carried from regular competition judging to the Altered Class judging. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed in the regular classes. **Two classes will be offered: Altered Male and Altered Female.** Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Confirmation of receipt of entry will be emailed (or phoned) to you.
- Confirmation of start time and order of classes (for Sweepstakes and Regular Show) will be confirmed by email after entries have closed.
- You MAY enter both the FCR Sweeps and the Lakehead Kennel Club All Breed Show on Friday (boosted).
- You may NOT enter the LKC All Breed Show on Saturday.
- You MAY enter the LKC All Breed Show on Sunday (boosted) as well as the Junior Hunt and/or Working Certificate. However, we cannot guarantee conflict free times for the WCI, WCX and Senior.

Junior handlers must compete in their age classification until they are old enough to move up to the next level. No entry fee will be charged but all dogs handled must be entered in the Specialty Show (obedience or conformation) in a regular class, altered class or for Exhibition Only by the closing date. Start of competition will be indicated in judging schedule. Advance notification by email would be appreciated, but not necessary. Rosettes will be awarded to the top four placements in each class and to the highest scoring Junior Handler. Prizes will also be awarded.

**ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS**

The current rate of exchange favours the American dollar. To take advantage of this situation, we have determined a US rate for entries. Personal checks or cash will be accepted at these rates. 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## PUPPY AND VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES AWARDS

75% of Sweepstakes entry fees will be divided as follows

BEST IN SWEEPSTAKES	10% of all sweepstake \$ received
BEST OF OPPOSITE	5% of all sweepstake \$ received
FIRST PLACE IN EACH CLASS	30% of all \$ received in this class + rosette
SECOND PLACE IN EACH CLASS	20% of all \$ received in this class + rosette
THIRD PLACE IN EACH CLASS	10% of all \$ received in this class + rosette
FOURTH PLACE IN EACH CLASS	rosette

## CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

**SECTION 15.1.1** A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

**SECTION 15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing <sup>*</sup>	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup>Includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

**SECTIONS 15.1.3 TO 15.1.7** (summary) To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

**SECTION 15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

**SECTION 15.1.9** A dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.

**SECTION 15.1.11** A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

CHAPTER 19.7 of the Conformation Show Rules state: It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
